



Templates For Kick Starting Your Reports

- Design a common layout for reports
- Determine a common color pallet
- Find out what legal information should appear on all reports.
- Create a versioning system for keeping track of reports.
- Create a set of templates





Templates

Reusable Components

- Datasets
- Datasources
- Tablixes and charts (Put in templates)
- Techniques and VBA code (put in knowledge base doc)






Reusable Components

Working With VBA Functions

- Variables
- Parameters
- Functions and Subroutines
- Calling Functions and Subroutines

=Code.<Function>(<Params>)

Working With Complex Parameters

- Cascading parameters
- Multi-value parameters
- Hidden Parameters
- Custom Parameters

Techniques For Exported Reports

CSV Files

Make sure to name the textboxes with good names. They will be the headers in the CSV Files

Excel Files

You can specify the tab that the data appears on

PDF Files

Document Maps become bookmarks





Exported Reports

Various Ways To Deploy Reports

- Linked Reports
 Use: Maintain 1 report, but change the parameters for users needs
- Exported on a schedule to a folder
 Use: XML Documents for another service
- Export snapshots for historical purposes or faster access
 Use: Pre-generate long running report during off hours
